BPFT Series Tables – General Care & Maintenance Instructions

NPS BPFT Series Tables are made for durability, and with a little care, they'll stay in great shape for years. Here are some tips:

- Maintain a relative humidity of 30% to 40% in the environment to help preserve the table.
- Keep the table away from heat sources like radiators, heating vents, and wood-burning stoves.
- Protect the table from prolonged direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to keep the finish looking pristine.
- Maintaining your table is easy with a simple damp cloth for regular cleaning!
- If there's a spill, wipe it away right away to prevent damage. For greasy stains, a water and vinegar mix works well.
- When moving your table, lift instead of dragging it.
- Avoid window cleaners, as ammonia can damage the finish.
- Though our tables are well-assembled, we recommend an annual check to ensure all screws stay securely in place.



PLASTIC

Always test a new cleaning product in an inconspicuous area to ensure it is safe to use.

CLEANING

Regularly wipe the tabletop with a gentle cleaning solution to keep dirt and grime away. Clean up spills immediately to avoid stains.

KEY CLEANING SOLUTION

Mix mild dish soap with warm water. Use a sponge to wipe down the tabletop, including the legs and edges.

DRYING

Dry the table completely with a cloth or paper towel to prevent water spots and streaks.

STAIN REMOVAL

For tough stains, sprinkle baking soda on the spot and gently scrub with a damp soft brush or sponge.

WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid abrasive cleaners or scrubbers, as they can scratch the plastic surface.

EXTRA CARE

For outdoor use, start by hosing down the table before applying the cleaning solution.

PROTECT THE SURFACE

Use tablecloths or placemats during meals or activities to prevent scratches, stains, and other damage.

CLEANING

Regularly wipe the tabletop with a gentle cleaning solution to prevent dirt buildup. Clean up spills right away to avoid stains.

KEY CLEANING SOLUTION

Mix mild dish soap with warm water and use a damp cloth to wipe off any marks.

DRYING

After cleaning, thoroughly dry the tabletop with a clean cloth to prevent water damage.

WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid harsh cleaners or abrasives on the powder-coated steel legs, as these can damage the finish. Extreme temperatures can also cause chipping and cracking, so protect from heat.
